There was discussion around potentially reviving efforts at recording living histories, to record stories of (and share digitally) internees, draft resisters, and others with a view towards increasing access to stories of Japanese American Colorado.

Treasurer's Report:

We have renewed our membership to the Asian Roundtable. Questions were raised about the need for our continued membership at the Roundtable, but no resolution or decisions.

Information and a budget have been furnished to the Chapter from Holly Yasui requesting \$14,000 from the Minoru Yasui Fund towards the creation of a documentary, memorializing Min. The family is supportive. The film is intended to be shown at the Min Yasui Building and there was discussion around the feasibility of Mile High JACL being able to show, share, archive, and post the video. There are requests to see a script from Holly. There is also a request to see a breakdown of where the funding is going in a more traditional grant request format. This would be to clarify where the funds from Mile High JACL would be going. A final question was raised around whether the funds would be going as a personal check or to a production company. No actions were moved.

Asian American Lobby Day has more co-sponsoring organizations, we are still in need of more attendees!
